Cost	Impact
Year 2 Climbing Trip £600 (Climbing) £300 (Coach – paid by the children)	All the year 2 children will be taken to White spider climbing wall to experience both top rope climbing and bouldering. This will also fit in with the outdoor and adventurous part of the national curriculum.
Cycling Proficiency for year 2 children Free	All year 2 children took part in a cycling proficiency course run by Surry County Council. This included road safety training and how to ride safely on the road.
National Sports Week Free	Sports week was a very successful event. We ran a different activity every day for all the children to take part in including basketball, karate, sports day for the whole school and a sponsored skip for the British heart foundation.
Emily Godwin, Lunch time Club Coach – Whole School (17 weeks) £510	Emily Godwin has been running a lunch time club for 17 weeks this year. Each week she runs activities for a different year group that focus on different aspects of outdoor games. By running a club at lunch time it is accessible to all children and we particularly target those children who are unlikely to take part in after school / out of school sporting activities.
Games kit with LDI log for children to wear when attending outside events. £105	We purchased a set of 15 Long Ditton Infant t-shirts for the children to wear when they travelled to events outside of school. This gave the children a sense of belonging to a team and representing their school.
Youth sport trust membership – renewed yearly £240	This membership gives the school free access to visits from athletes, CPD for teachers and entry to school games events. It also gives us access to a lot of online CPD materials.
Supply cover for teaching staff to attend the BUPA Start to Move course x 2 £300	The BUPA Start to Move course was attended by 2 teachers this year. The course aims to equip teachers with the techniques and confidence to teach core movement skills. Give children the movement skills, enthusiasm and confidence to begin lifelong participation

	in physical activity and sport and support learning in PE in ways similar to other subjects, i.e. helping children to learn the ABCs of movement.
Equipment – old equipment replaced and new equipment bought for both gymnastics and outdoor games use. £1230	We replaced a large amount of old and broken equipment as well as purchasing new gymnastic equipment to improve teaching and learning for the children. We also purchased basketball equipment as we are running a basketball club from September 2014.
Supply for PE subject leader to attend training and observe other staff x 3 £450	Supply cover for the PE subject leader to observe all staff teaching PE and attend training on the Sports Premium Funding and Surrey Multi skills games event in Guildford.
Reception school trip to High Ashurst for An Introduction to the Outdoor Classroom Cost £590	All the reception children attended the session at High Ashurst. They got to take part in team building activities and problem solving tasks to develop team work, communication and co-operation. They also took part in a low ropes challenge course. All the children really enjoyed this experience and produced lots of writing related to the trip once they returned to school.
Coach for Surrey school games in Guildford £170	15 children from year 1 and 2 attended this event. It was the only competitive event available for KS1 children to enter in Surrey. The children took part in 12 multi-sport events and had to compete against themselves to beat their personal best. All the children really enjoyed this event and it was an excellent experience for them to compete with other schools. The 60 children from year 1 and 2 also attended a inter schools multi skills event at Hinchley Wood Primary. The cost of this was free as we walked to and from the event.
LW – Monday TA teaching (1:45 till 3:00pm) with SEN children and pupil premium. Fine and Gross motor skills. Cost for 12 weeks - £1440	LW an experienced TA ran groups for children in reception, year 1 and year 2 focusing on gross motor skills and team work. She also ran one group for children who were more reluctant to take part in PE to build up their confidence and self-esteem.
