<p><u>Cycling Proficiency for year 2 children (60 chn)</u></p> <p>Free</p>	<p>All year 2 children will take part in a cycling proficiency course run by Surry County Council. This will included road safety training and how to ride safely on the road.</p>
<p><u>Youth sport trust membership</u></p> <p>£200</p>	<p>This membership gives the school free access to athlete visits, CPD for teachers and entry to school games events. It also gives us access to a lot of online CPD materials.</p>
<p><u>Year 2 inter school sports competition</u></p> <p>Supply for specialist PE leader - £250</p> <p>Transport - free - to be provided by parents or free travel on bus</p>	<p>A number of events held over the year for Year 2 children. They get a chance to compete in events against children from other schools. From the event attended last year, the children enjoyed showcasing their talents and loved attending the event.</p> <p>We will also attend 3 events at Hinchley Wood school in the summer term for 60 children to take part in a multi sports competition against other local schools.</p>
<p><u>Year 2 - Tennis trip</u></p> <p>Free</p> <p>Coach?</p>	<p>Children to go to Surbiton racket and fitness club to play tennis and watch others playing tennis. Children will learn how to hold a racket and correct technique hitting the ball.</p>
<p><u>Year 1 trip - SOLD</u></p> <p>£940 - (estimate - not booked yet)</p>	<p>Children to visit Thames Young Mariners. They will take part in team building activities, orienteering, den building. This will help develop their fitness skills (gross motor), as well as relating to other areas of the curriculum, such as Geography.</p>
<p><u>Year 2 trip - Rock climbing (White spider) - need to confirm with teachers and book</u></p> <p>£825 (1:4 instructor - £55ph per instructor) £30ph for the function room x 3 £90)</p>	<p>Year 2 children to go on a school trip to White spider rock climbing. This will develop their climbing skills, gross motor skills, co-ordination and develop their confidence.</p>

<p><u>Sports companies to come in during sports week - TBC</u></p> <p>£275 - Fencing</p> <p>£375 - Dan the skipping man</p> <p>£350-400 - Goodlife gymnastics</p> <p><u>Sports for Schools - athlete</u> Free</p>	<p>Sports week - invite a different sports company in every day.</p> <p>An athlete to visit the school and work with the children to do 4 different exercises as a circuit. Then there will be an assembly for the children to listen to the athlete about his/her journey. This will allow children to be active, and also give them an insight to an athlete's life.</p>
<p><u>Sports coaches lunchtime clubs</u></p> <p>£3,150 £5,700 (for the full year next year)</p>	<p>Sports coaches to come in at lunch times 5 x to do sport with the children - focussing on games.</p> <p>This will develop the children's skills in games and ensure that they are active during lunch time.</p>
<p><u>Training for staff</u></p> <p>£112.50 - gymnastics training (INSET)</p> <p>£200 - PE conference for PE co-ordinator</p> <p>£250 - Supply</p> <p>£132 - Network meetings</p> <p>Dance training 2hr Twilight Inset - £270</p>	<p>To increase the staff's knowledge in gymnastics and dance to develop confidence teaching it. This will then benefit the children and ensure that the curriculum requirements are being met.</p> <p>PE conference - for the PE coordinator to develop confidence in the subject area and expectations of the role.</p>
<p><u>Experienced PE Lecturers to come in and team teach with staff</u></p> <p>Lecturers to work with teachers to team teach in areas they are less confident in £100ph (1-hour x 8 teachers) £800</p>	<p>To develop teachers' knowledge and confidence in teaching areas of PE where they have less confidence. This will help the teachers become more confident in that area, and allows them the opportunity to talk to the experiences lecturers about progression in that subject.</p>
<p><u>1 day PE cover for PE co-ordinator to observe PE in other schools</u></p> <p>£250</p>	<p>PE co-ordinator to go to schools in Ember Learning Trust to meet with PE co-ordinators and observe PE in other schools.</p> <p>This will be beneficial for the PE co-ordinator to see how PE is taught in different schools and to look at planning and take ideas.</p>
<p><u>1 day cover for PE co-ordinator</u></p> <p>£250</p>	<p>PE co-ordinator to: phone of companies to organise to come in during sports week; look into and buy PE scheme of work/lesson plans; meet with experienced</p>

	PE lecturer to ask for advice on schemes of work
<u>Half day cover to observe PE:</u> £150	PE co-ordinator to observe PE teaching in KS1 class. Observe the teaching against national curriculum and meet with teachers after to discuss progressions in the lesson and positives and improvements. This will help the PE co-ordinator to see the PE teaching taking place in school and help the teachers progress.
<u>PE Lesson plans for Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2</u> Jim Hall lesson plans - £53.50 Leap into Life - £110.50	Lesson plans in dance, gym and games. This is to help the teachers to plan for PE, to ensure coverage and progression. This therefore ensures that the children are progressing in PE across the school.
<u>SOLD trip for Reception</u> - £934.50	All the reception children will visit Thames Young Mariners to take part in 'An Introduction to the outdoor classroom'. They will take part in team building activities and problem solving tasks to develop team work, communication and co-operation. This will also help to develop their physical development.
<u>New sports equipment (in EYFS outdoor area, hall and school playground)</u> £950	Children to use the equipment in garden and playground to help develop their gross motor skills and to ensure that the children stay active and healthy.
