# What to bring to Nursery

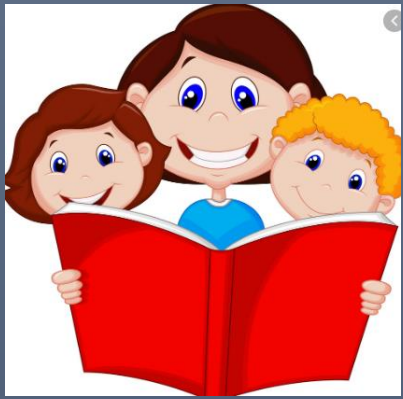


- A water bottle filled with water only.
- A packed lunch if your child is staying all day or for lunch club.
- A weatherproof coat.
- Book bag.
- Library book returned on Thursdays.
- A bag with spare clothes and plastic bag in case of toilet or water accidents that can be kept at Nursery.
- Please encourage your child to leave their own toys at home to keep them safe, thank you!
- Please make sure all items are named.



## **Helpful tips for packed lunches**

- *Just a few items is better – 4 or 5.*
- *Not too much of each item*
- *Include some fruit or vegetables cut up eg. carrot sticks, cucumber sticks, apple slices, halved grapes.*
- *Try and include a variety of foods eg. small pot of pasta or a wrap instead of a sandwich.*
- *Due to allergies, please do not include nuts or sesame or foods containing these items.*
- *We are a healthy school, so please no chocolate, chocolate biscuits/cakes.*
- *A few crisps is ok. Popcorn is even better!*
- *Remember to include a spoon or fork if needed.*



# Library Books

- On **Thursday** your child will bring a library book home.
- Please return it on the following Thursday.
- Only return books to us on a Thursday so that we can keep track of quarantining the books, thank you!
- Once your book has been returned your child will be able to select another book.
- Encourage your child to handle the book with care.
- Please wipe clean the book before returning it.
- Please return the book in the condition that you received it.
- We understand accidents happen and books may get lost or damaged, please just speak to us so that we know.

# Toileting & Spare Clothes

- We give all children frequent toilet reminders.
- We will encourage your child to go to the toilet independently.
- We will reassure them that if they need help they need to ask, please talk to your child at home about asking for help if they need it!
- We will help children to get changed where necessary.
- Please remember to send in spare clothes in case of toilet accidents with a plastic bag for wet clothes, all in a named bag to be kept at Nursery. Clothes to include pants, socks, joggers/leggings, t-shirt/sweatshirt.
- If your child comes home in their spare clothes, please remember to send in replacements!
- If your child has borrowed nursery clothes please ensure they are washed at 60 degrees before returning them. Thank you!



*Any suitable bag will do - please remember to name it.*



# Suitable Clothing Reminders

For All Weathers!

- Uniform is optional.
- All clothing worn or brought to nursery should be named.
- Please send a weatherproof coat to nursery everyday, we go out in all weathers!
- Please send a sun hat on hot days and a warm hat on cold days.
- We are unable to apply sun cream to your child, please apply this before they come to nursery.
- Please ensure your child is wearing suitable closed toe shoes, sandals can be unsafe in the nursery environment, thank you!
- Please name everything!



# Wow Stars!

- Every half term we will send home some WOW Stars for you to complete.
- Please write on the star something amazing that your child has achieved.
- Bring it in to nursery and we will be able to share it and say "Well Done!"
- Some examples of WOW things are:
  - Putting on their shoes independently
  - Putting on their coat independently
  - Trying to brush their teeth
  - Using the toilet
  - Helping with the washing
- These can be everyday tasks and will be individual to your child.
