<p>Cycling Proficiency for year 2 children</p> <p>Free</p>	<p>All year 2 children will take part in a cycling proficiency course run by Surry County Council. This will included road safety training and how to ride safely on the road.</p>
<p>Reception school trip to Thames Young Mariners – An Introduction to the outdoor classroom.</p> <p>£594 (approx.) Coach – cover by the children</p>	<p>All the reception children will visit Thames Young Mariners to take part in - An Introduction to the outdoor classroom. They will take part in team building activities and problem solving tasks to develop team work, communication and co-operation. They will also take part in a low ropes challenge course.</p>
<p>Year 2 Climbing Trip</p> <p>£600 (Climbing) £300 (Coach – paid by the children)</p>	<p>All the year 2 children will be taken to White spider climbing wall to experience both top rope climbing and bouldering. This will also fit in with the outdoor and adventurous part of the national curriculum.</p>
<p>Lunch time games club – all year</p> <p>Cost £25 per hour 1 x a week (£950)</p>	<p>Emily Godwin will be running lunch time games club for approx. 38 weeks this year. Each week she will run activities for a different year group that focus on different aspects of outdoor games. By running a club at lunch time it is accessible to all children and we particularly target those children who are unlikely to take part in after school / out of school sporting activities.</p>
<p>Gymnastics/Outdoor Games – Year 1 (whole morning)</p> <p>£25 an hour = £50 per day – Paid to Ultimate Coaching 36 weeks x £50 per day = £1250</p>	<p>An outside coach from Ultimate coaching will be teaching year 1 gymnastics for the rest of the year (1 class each week). This will be used as CPD for staff as they will also be team teaching lessons and teaching lessons observed by the sports coach.</p>

<p>Outdoor Games – Year 2 and reception</p> <p>36 weeks x £160 per week £5760*</p> <p>The cost of most of this will be covered through dodgeball club.</p>	<p>An outside coach from Primary Sporting Development will be teaching games to reception and year 2 (Tuesday and Thursday morning). This will be used as CPD for staff as they will also be team teaching lessons and teaching lessons observed by the sports coach.</p>
<p>Youth sport trust membership</p> <p>£210 (already paid)</p>	<p>This membership gives the school free access to athlete visits, CPD for teachers and entry to school games events. It also gives us access to a lot of online CPD materials.</p>
<p>Coach for Surrey School Games in Guildford</p> <p>£170</p>	<p>15 children from year 1 and 2 attended this event. It was the only competitive event available for KS1 children to enter in Surrey. The children took part in 12 multi-sport events and had to compete against themselves to beat their personal best. All the children really enjoyed this event and it was an excellent experience for them to compete with other schools.</p> <p>We will also attend 3 events at Hinchley Wood school in the summer term for 60 children to take part in a multi sports competition against other local schools.</p>
<p>Fit for sport level 2 play leader course</p> <p>Around £300 for a half-day session</p>	<p>Lunch time supervisors to be sent on a course to be trained in playing different games with the children. Means chn can participate in games on the playground.</p>
