- The keynote speaker is Sir John Jones who will explain the important role of teachers in changing people's lives.

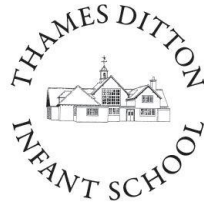
# Latest news
