Phonics:

1. Revise sound set 1 and 2 daily

Ruth Miskin, who developed the Read, Write, Inc programme, is doing daily sessions on youtube. These are interactive, very easy to follow and similar to the lessons the children do in class.

We suggest that you watch the speed sounds 2 programme and run through speed sounds 1 independently.

2. Sound of the week 'ir': Rhyme: whirl and twirl

Practise blending words with 'ay' and the 'ir' sounds

Suggestions:

Real words: say, pray, day, may, bird, tired, stay, spray, crayon

Nonsense words: dird, pirl, sirl, tay, cray

Go for a word hunt around your house like Geraldine

3. Write a sentence

Choose one of your 'ay' words and one of your 'ir' words

Think of a sentence containing each of your chosen words. Repeat it a few times (hold it) and then write it down.

Remember to use your sound mat.

Literacy:

1. We hope you have been accessing pobble365 and looking at the daily picture. There is some really helpful guidance attached to the pictures including talking activities with suggested questions together with sentence and story starters.

We would love to hear or read some of your sentences. Send us a photo of your writing or a recording.

Challenge: write the beginning of the story, and use some exciting story language . Try to make it 3-4 sentences long.

2. Mrs Dawes is very bored of her sandwiches at lunchtime and wants some suggestions as to different sandwich fillings. Can you make up and write a silly sentence, suggesting a sandwich filling?

e.g. **My** silly sandwich is cheese and grass.

Remember to spot the **red** words.

3. Draw a picture, take a photo of your work and send it to us. Looking forward to trying your fillings!

Understanding of the world

It is lovely weather at the moment can you go into your garden or on a walk and find a flower or plant that you think is beautiful. Don't pick it, take a photo and then when you are at home:

Look closely at your flower

- how the colours change
- whether there are any patterns on the stem, petals or leaves
- what shape are the different parts of the flower are.

Draw your flower and colour it in

Try to label the different parts of the flower. e.g. stalk, leaf, stem, petal

Maths

This week we would like you to think about length and height. Can you find objects around your home that are different lengths or heights? Which is the longest/tallest? Which is the shortest?

Can you place these objects in order? We would love to see some pictures of the different ordered objects that you have used. Perhaps you could label them, so we know which is the longest/tallest and which is the shortest?




Write the words and then colour the ones with an 'ir' sound in them.


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Caterpillar Measuring

Look carefully at the caterpillars and check which colour they need to be.




- = longest caterpillar

- = other caterpillars




Caterpillar Measuring

Look carefully at the caterpillars and check which colour they need to be.




- = longest caterpillar

Giraffe Measuring


Look carefully at the giraffes and check which colour they need to be.

- = other giraffes



Giraffe Measuring

Look carefully at the giraffes and check which colour they need to be.




- = tallest giraffe
