




Nursery Home Learning Summer 1 Week 3: Houses & Homes

Maths - Shape Hunting

Practise counting everyday!

It is important for children to play and explore with shapes and have hands-on experiences. Can you go on a shape hunt around your home? Talk about the different shapes that you find.

Key Vocabulary: circle, triangle, square, oblong, cone, cylinder, cube, cuboid, sphere. Talk about the difference between 2d shapes (flat shapes) and 3d shapes (solid/fat shapes)

Houses and Homes

Talk about your home together: Count the different types of rooms in your home. Talk about the use of each room in your home. Look at different types of homes around you or research pictures together on the internet. What shapes did you see around your home?
